
The survey was run using EUSurvey from 26th April to 5th August 2021 The survey contained 4 sections. In total there were 27 questions.





NEWCOMERS' past experience of HORIZON 2020




REASONS FOR NEWCOMERS TO PARTICIPATE

TRL 5: Large Scale Prototype






